Monthly Tuition (effective 04/01/2023)

Highlighted Fees & Policies:

- A \$200 non-refundable processing fee is due at time of enrollment.
- An annual registration fee of \$75/child is due every September (incoming enrollments after September will be prorated at \$6.25/month).
- If it is discovered by a Village Little staff member that a child is not signed in or out, a \$25 administrative fee will be assessed (see page 8-9 of our Parent Handbook for details).
- All plan changes will be charged an administrative fee of \$25 (limited to one charge per family). Withdrawal from the program requires written notice at least one month in advance.
- All fees are due on the 1st of the month prior to attending. A late fee of \$25 (limited to \$25 per family) will be assessed for payments received after the 10th. After the 15th, if payment is not received, child care services may be suspended.
- 100% of the tuition is due every month throughout the year regardless of school closure dates or attendance. Tuition may increase at any time with at least one month's prior notice.
- Refund conditions: All fees are charged on the basis of enrollment, not attendance. Refunds/prorates cannot be granted for absences, illness, vacation or school closures. When you enroll, you are reserving time, space, staffing and provisions, whether or not your child attends. Refunds will be given for overpayment of fees or paid time after your one month cancellation notice has elapsed. Refunds will not be given if your child is suspended or terminated from the program.
- Substituting days within the week is not an option. If additional days of service are required, and space is available, drop-in rates will be assessed and payment is due on the day service is provided.

Additional Charges:

Late Pick-Up Charges: (pick-up times: 12:30pm half-day, 3:30pm ³/₄-day & 5pm full-day)

- \$25 late fee for 1-10 minutes after pick-up
- \$50 late fee for 11-20 minutes after pick-up
- \$75 late fee for 21-30 minutes after pick-up
